Tip Slater is Chief Financial Officer of the Network Centric Operations Industry Consortium (NCOIC). In this role, he provides financial leadership for the business operations and directs all new business activity for the international, non-profit organization that specializes in creating interoperability within businesses, industries, government and non-governmental organizations.

Before joining NCOIC, Slater worked for a decade with The Boeing Company, where he was director of Virtual Operations, responsible for developing a high-speed network environment of more than 150 high-tech laboratories that increased productivity, created new capability and dramatically reduced costs for the corporation. His other positions included deputy director of Strategic Architecture for Boeing Integrated Defense Systems and director of Business Development for Boeing Government Information and Communications Systems.

Slater also had a distinguished career in the U.S. Air Force, retiring as a Colonel. He flew KC-135 and RC-135 aircraft and was involved in RC-135, U-2 and SR-71 operations. He helped develop command, control and intelligence operations for the U.S. Central Command and also commanded U.S.A.F. communications units.

Slater received a Master of Aeronautical Science degree from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Florida and a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of Massachusetts Lowell.
