Cohen also serves as librarian of the Network Centric Operations Industry Consortium, responsible for establishing and maintaining a common library framework for NCOIC processes and key documents. She recommends and develops framework documents to enable consistent implementation of NCOIC processes as well as catalogs product documents in the consortium's Processes and Procedures Library for access by NCOIC members. Additional responsibility includes coordination and processing of new member applications.

Prior to joining NCOIC, Cohen worked for more than 30 years at The Boeing Company, where she served as a business integration project manager, process integration manager and executive staff analyst. She led process change management and quality operations, ISO 9001 and AS9100 compliance, and project management and planning. She also provided support to the Boeing-led team that formed NCOIC in 2004.
